I understand that this is a preliminary order. River Country RC&D Council, Inc. will pool the orders and develop a volume discount "Request for Bids" which will be sent out to nurseries. The nurseries will return the bids to River Country who will rank and accept bids.

All orders must be received by River Country by January 13th, 2012.

I understand that I will receive an invoice in February of 2012. This invoice will itemize the cost of my order based on the bids accepted. I have 10 days to remit to River Country 10% of the order amount. **If River Country RC&D Council, Inc. does not receive this payment within 10 days of my receipt of the invoice, my order will be cancelled.**

The remaining balance on my account is due at the time of pick up – in April 2012. I also understand my **10% down payment is non-refundable** unless River Country RC&D Council cannot supply the seed to fill the invoice.

I understand that I WILL PICK UP the seed from Eau Claire.
